


Terminal, console, shell

cd sites/default/files = change into directory cp example.settings.php settings.php = COPY rm mytemplate.html.twig = remove file or directory mkdir my theme = make directory for new theme pwd = **p**rint **w**orking **d**irectory





Export/import configuration
