


### Introduction

Document management has become a very important aspect to companies/ organizations in todays world and almost all companies use documents on a daily basis for their work. But do they manage the documents properly?





### Problem

### Solution - Pros


- The user will have access to all they need within one system

- We can collaborate easily when everything is one place.








