


Drupal projects

Asia, Africa highest D8







Drupal dev team size






Team Size vs Projects

Largest shops reflect overall project averages.






Not surprisingly, the number of other developers, (FE, JS, etc.) correlates to the number of Drupal devs on a team.



Custom Docker top favorite in Europe


Vagrant and WAMP/ XAMPP popular in Asia

DDev, WAMP top in Africa homebrew jumps from #12 to #5




Local Development Tools by Drupal Team Size






Local Development Tools by Project Type




