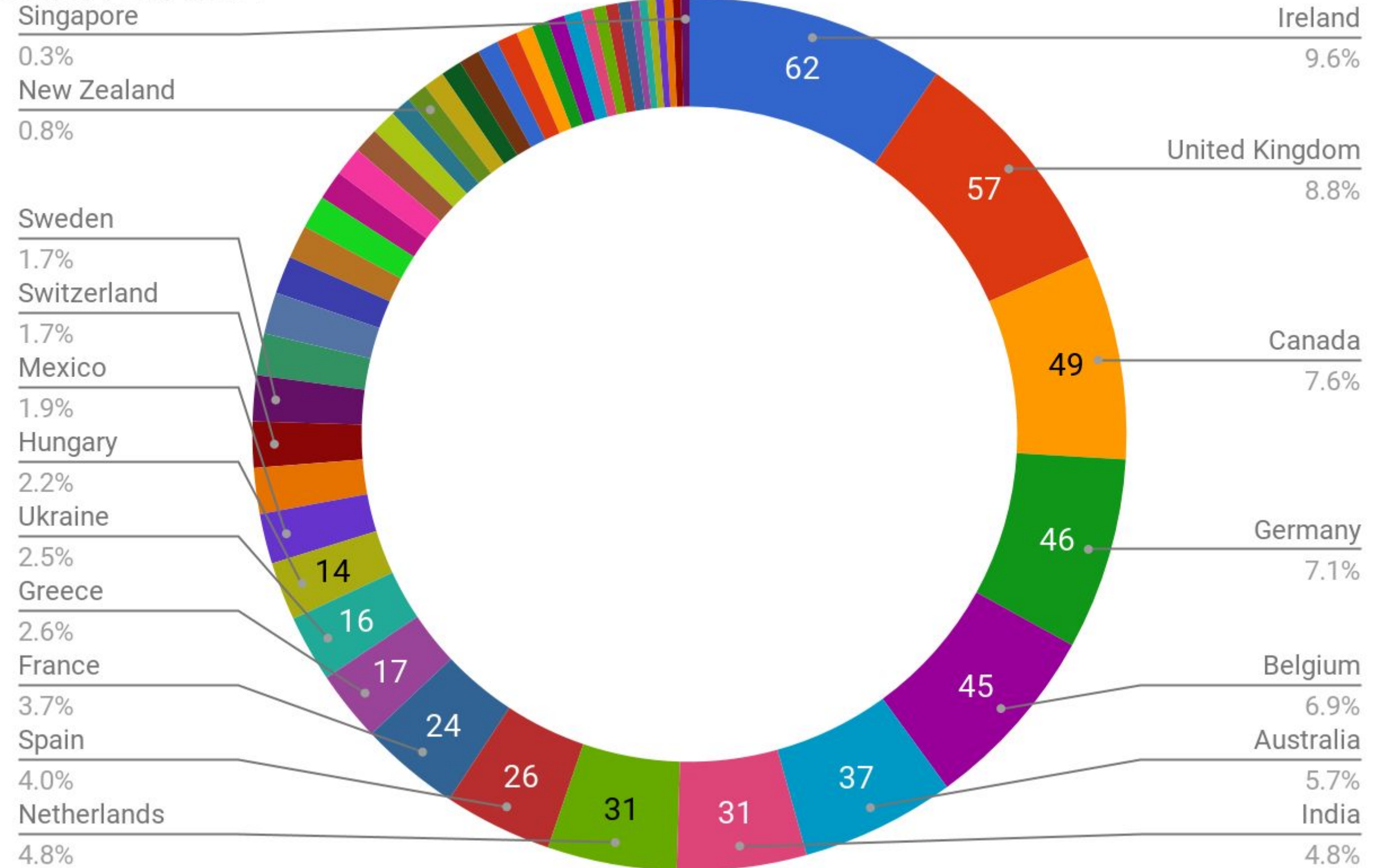

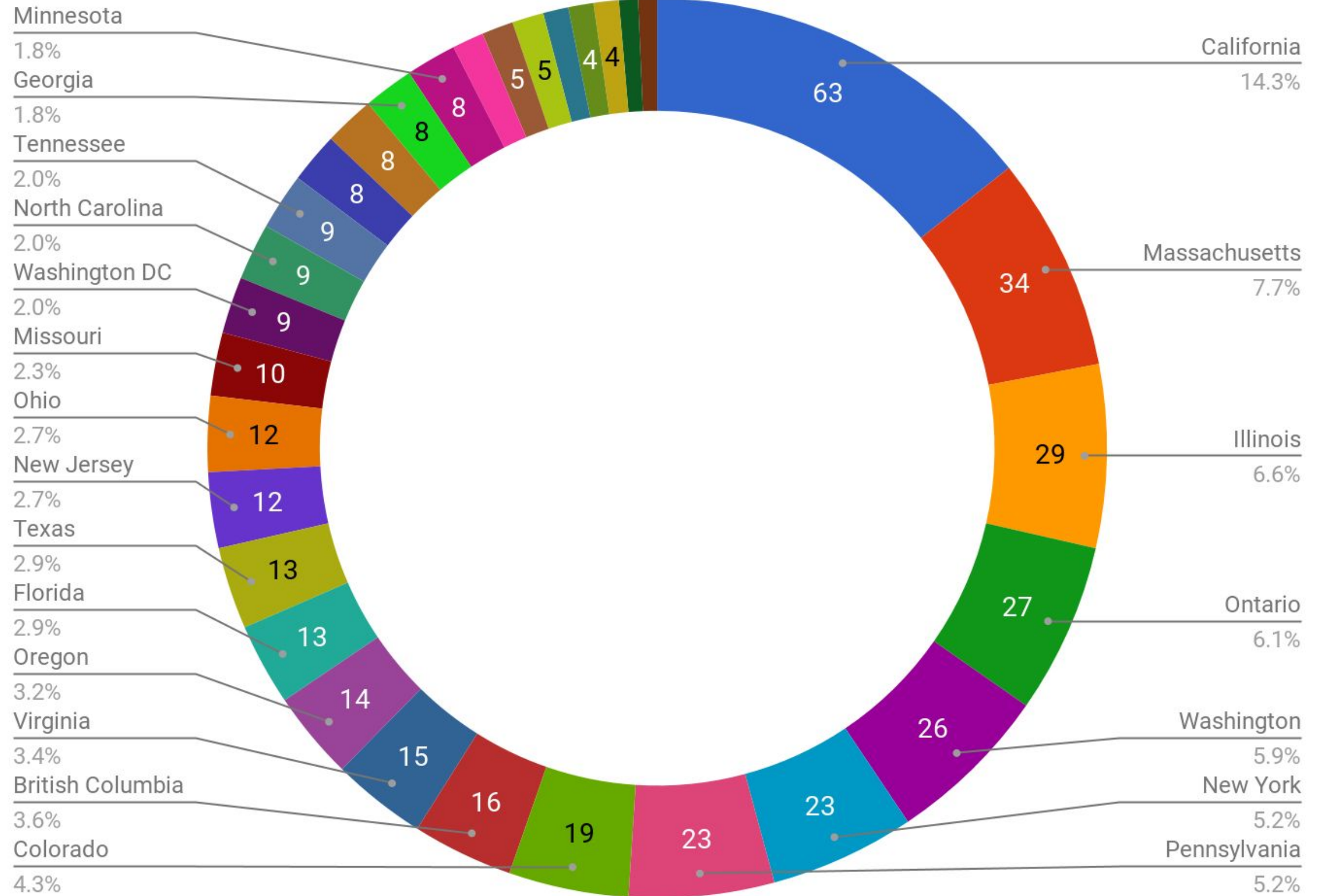

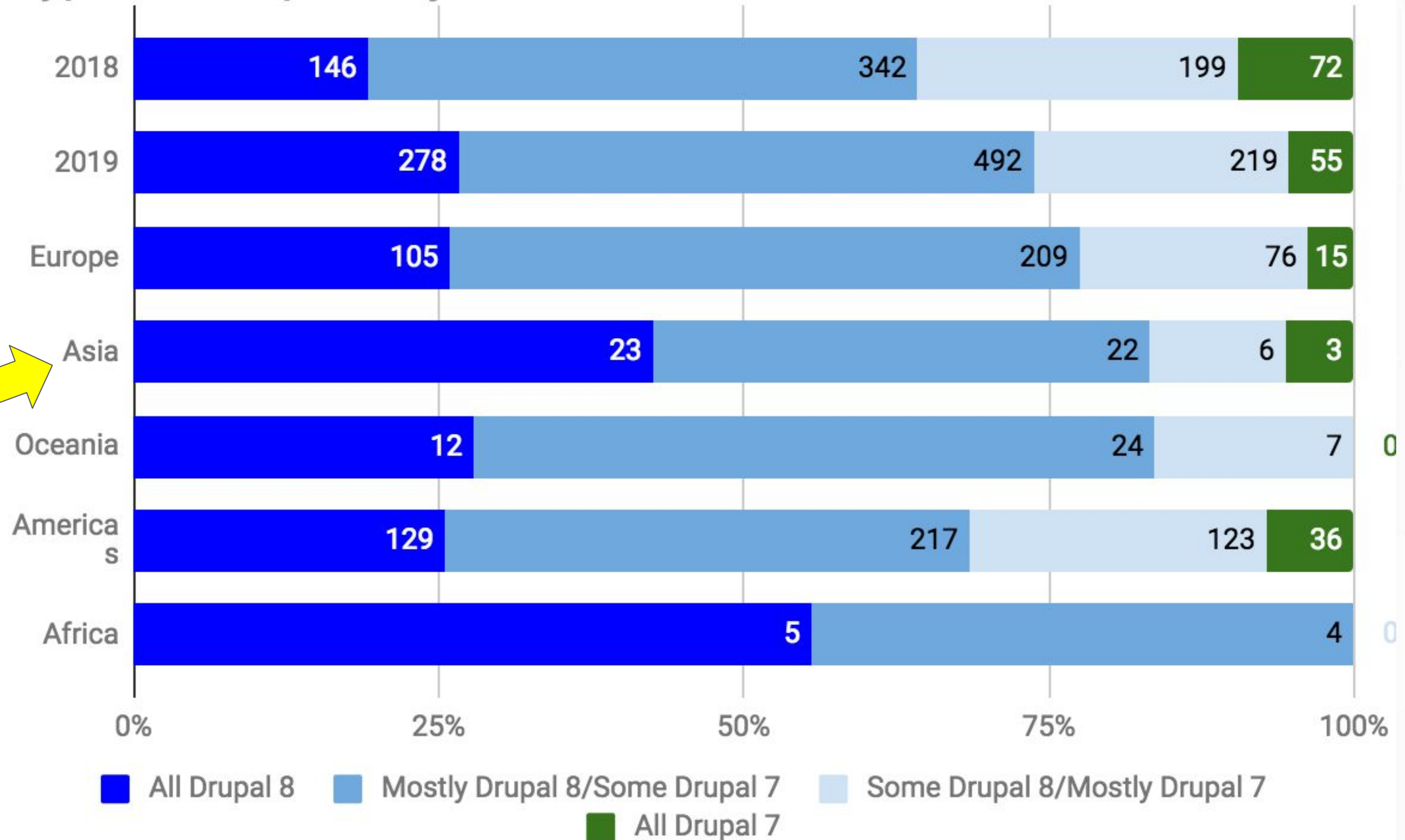

Types of Drupal Projects



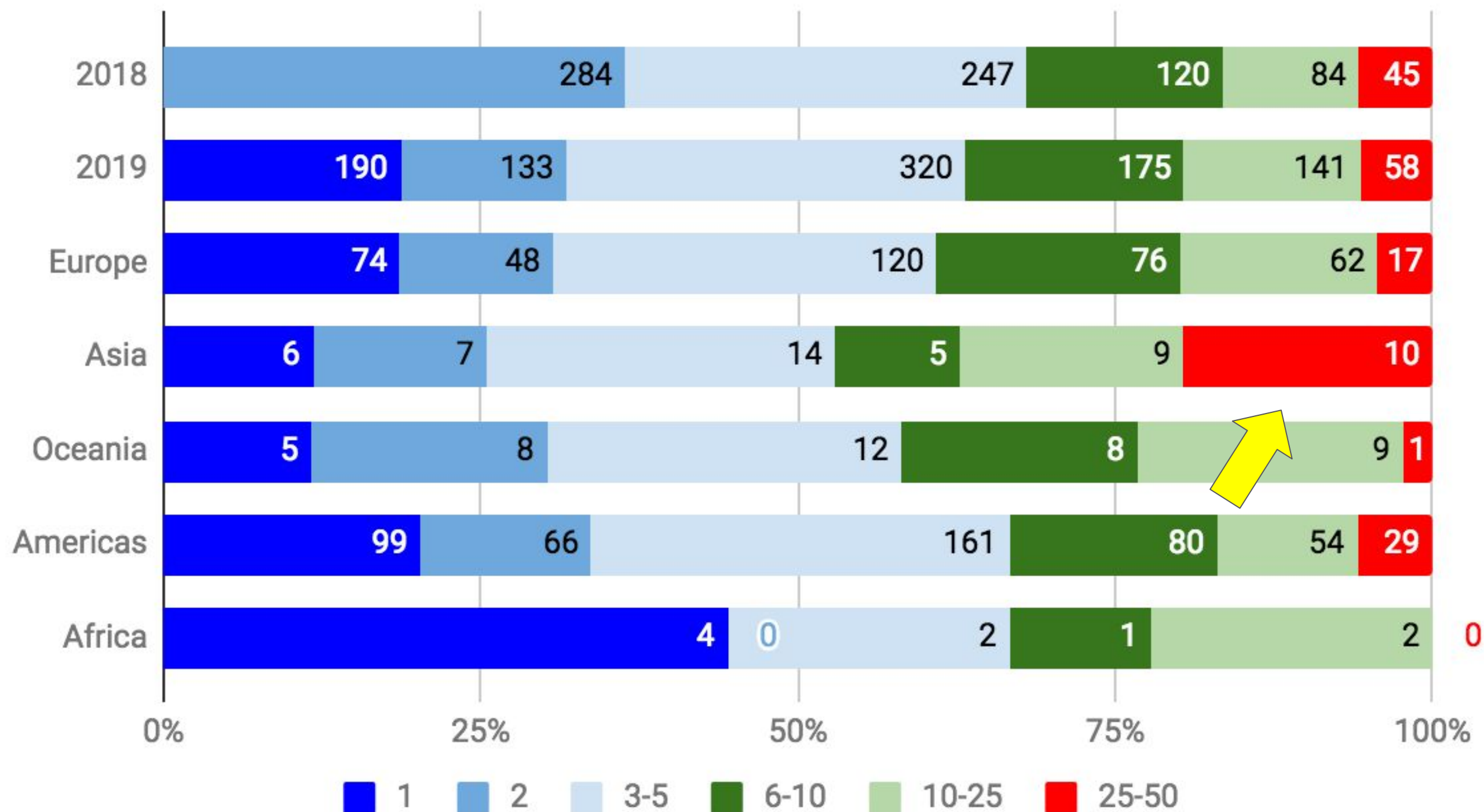

Drupal dev team size



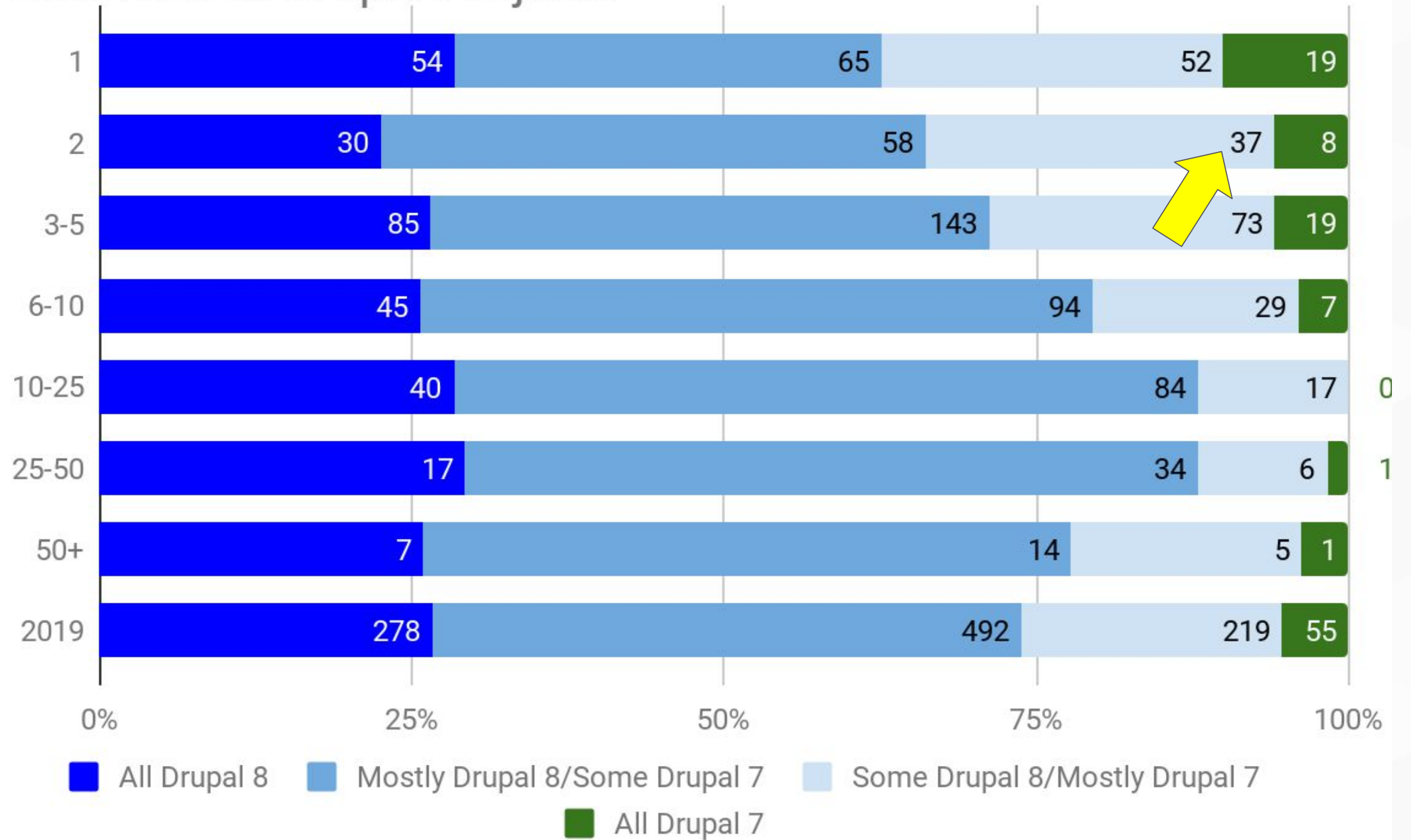
Team Size vs Projects

Other dev team sizes

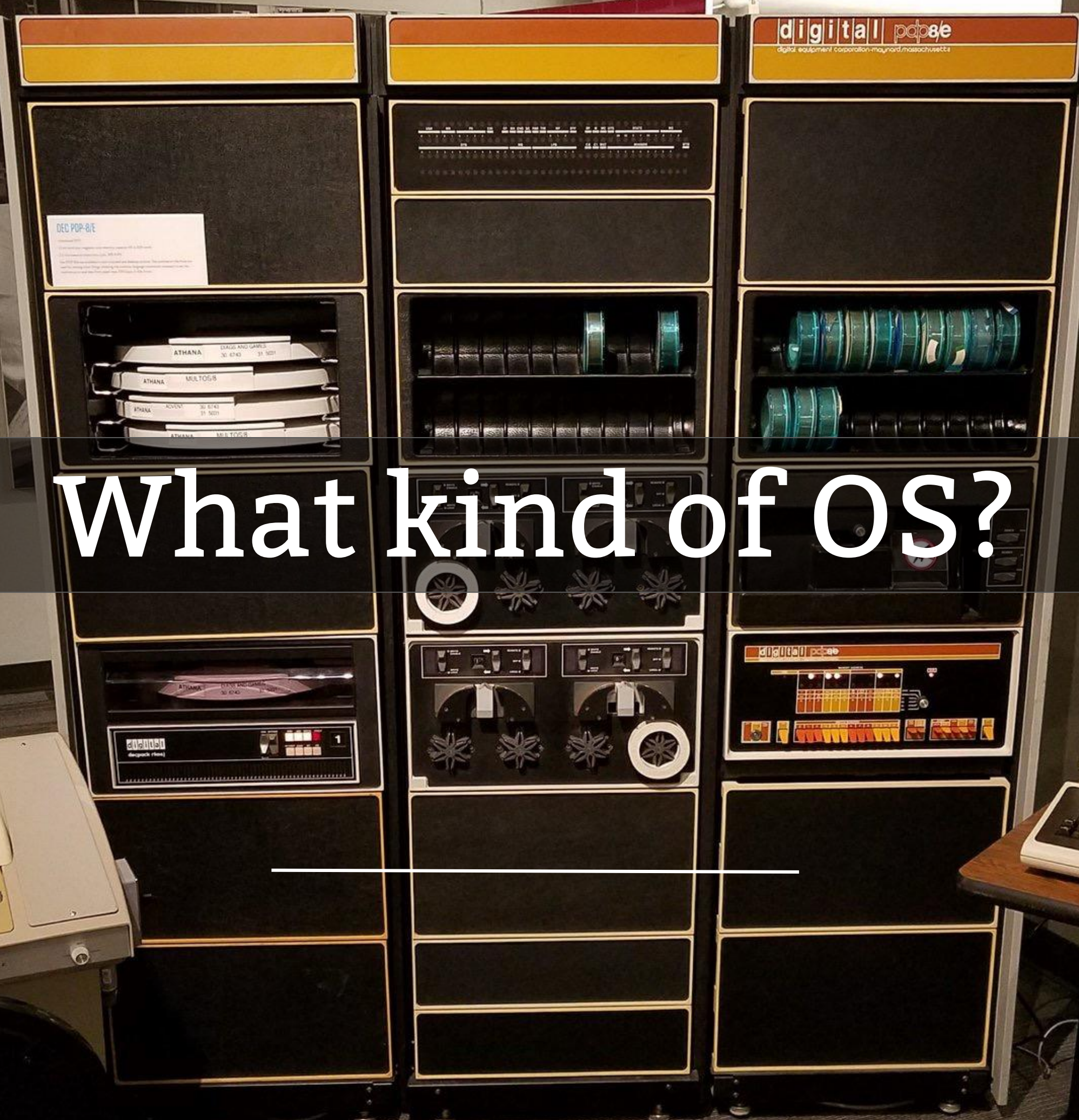
Not surprisingly, the number of other developers, (FE, JS, etc.) correlates to the number of Drupal devs on a team.

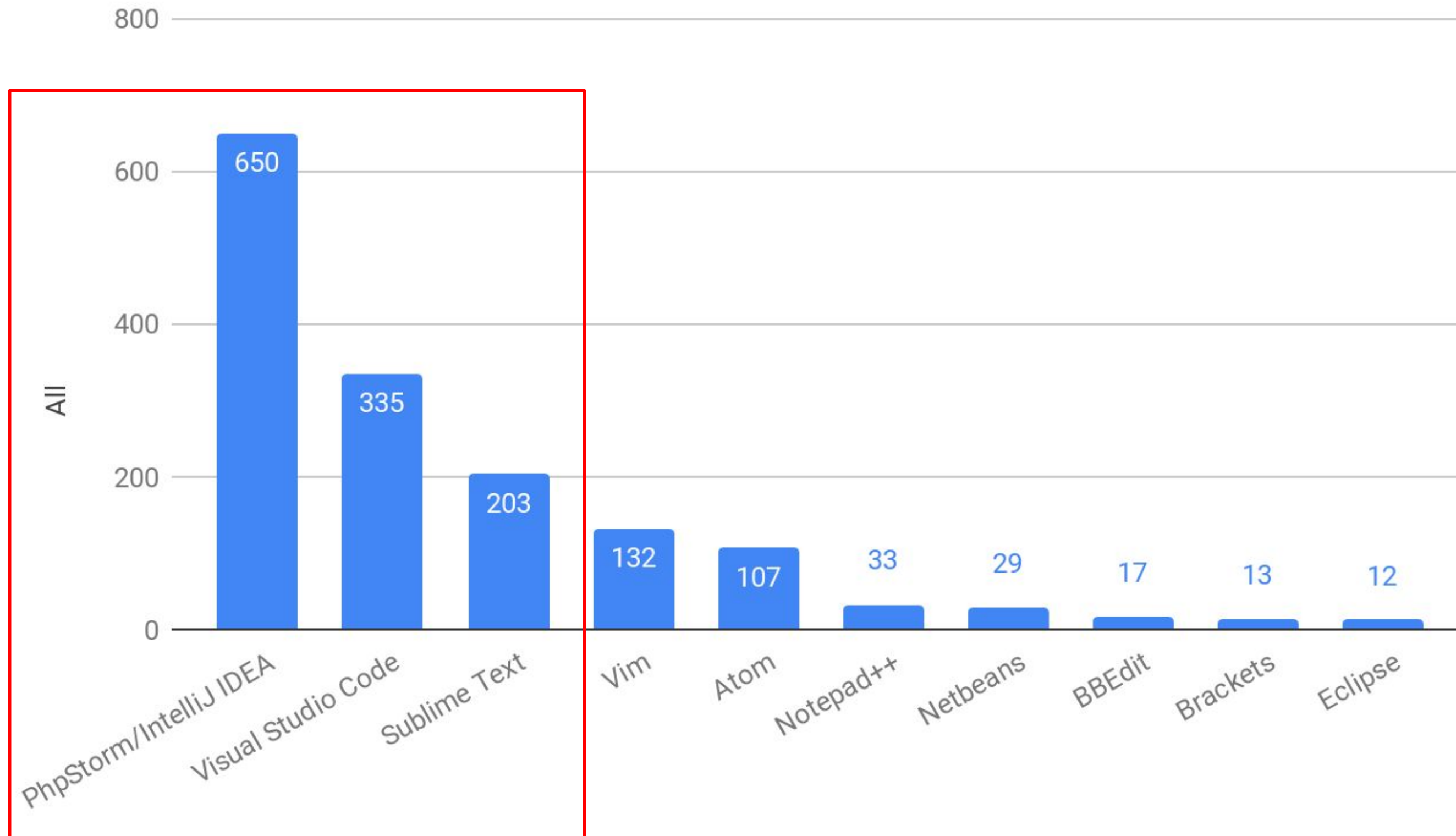

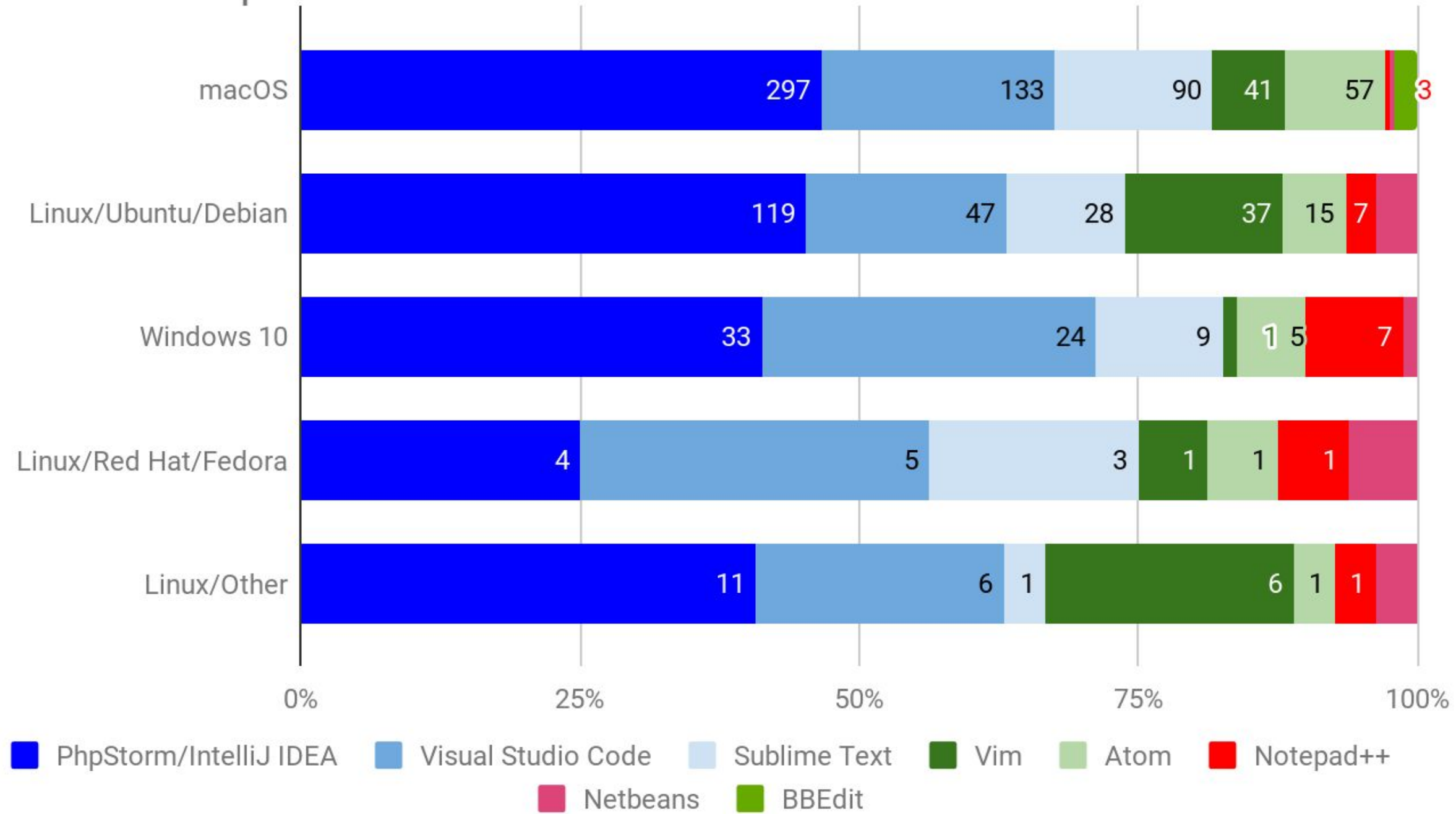
Code Development vs Team Size

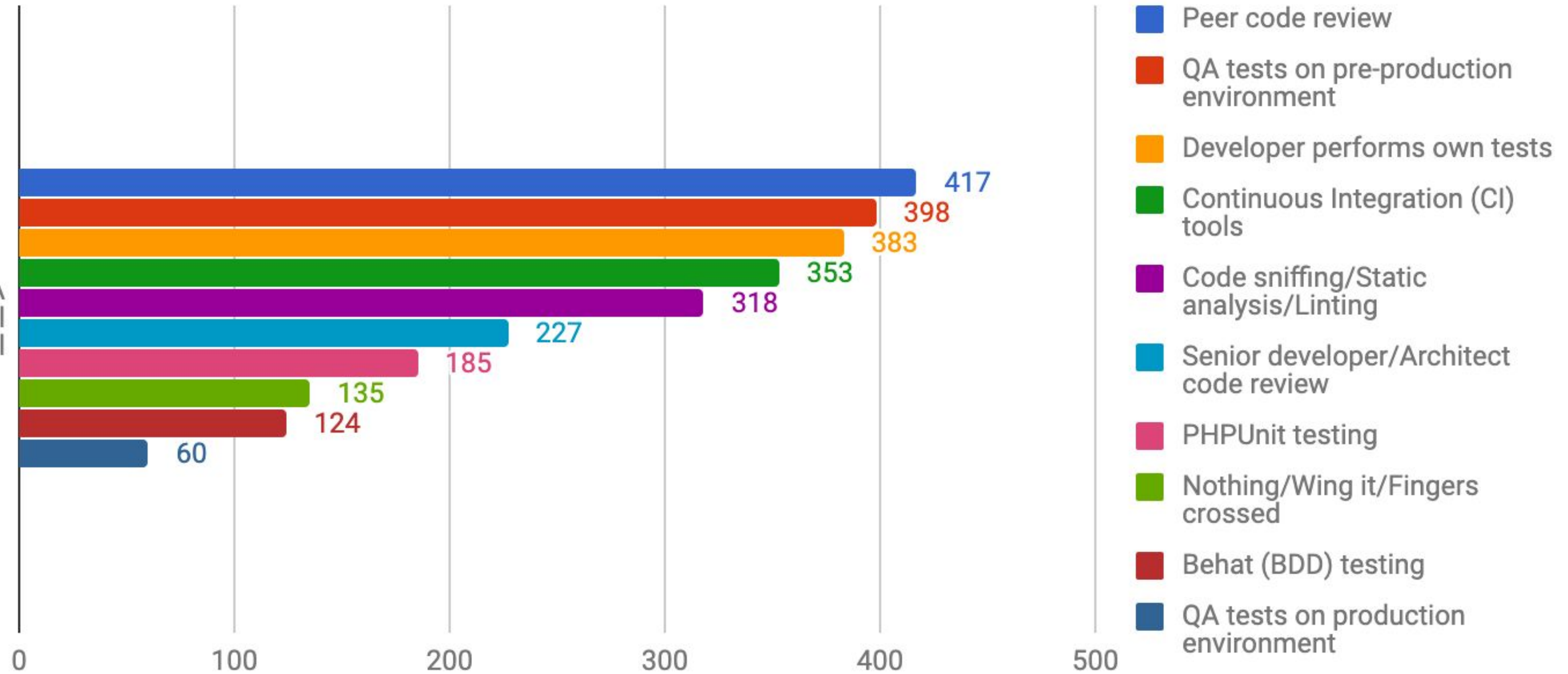

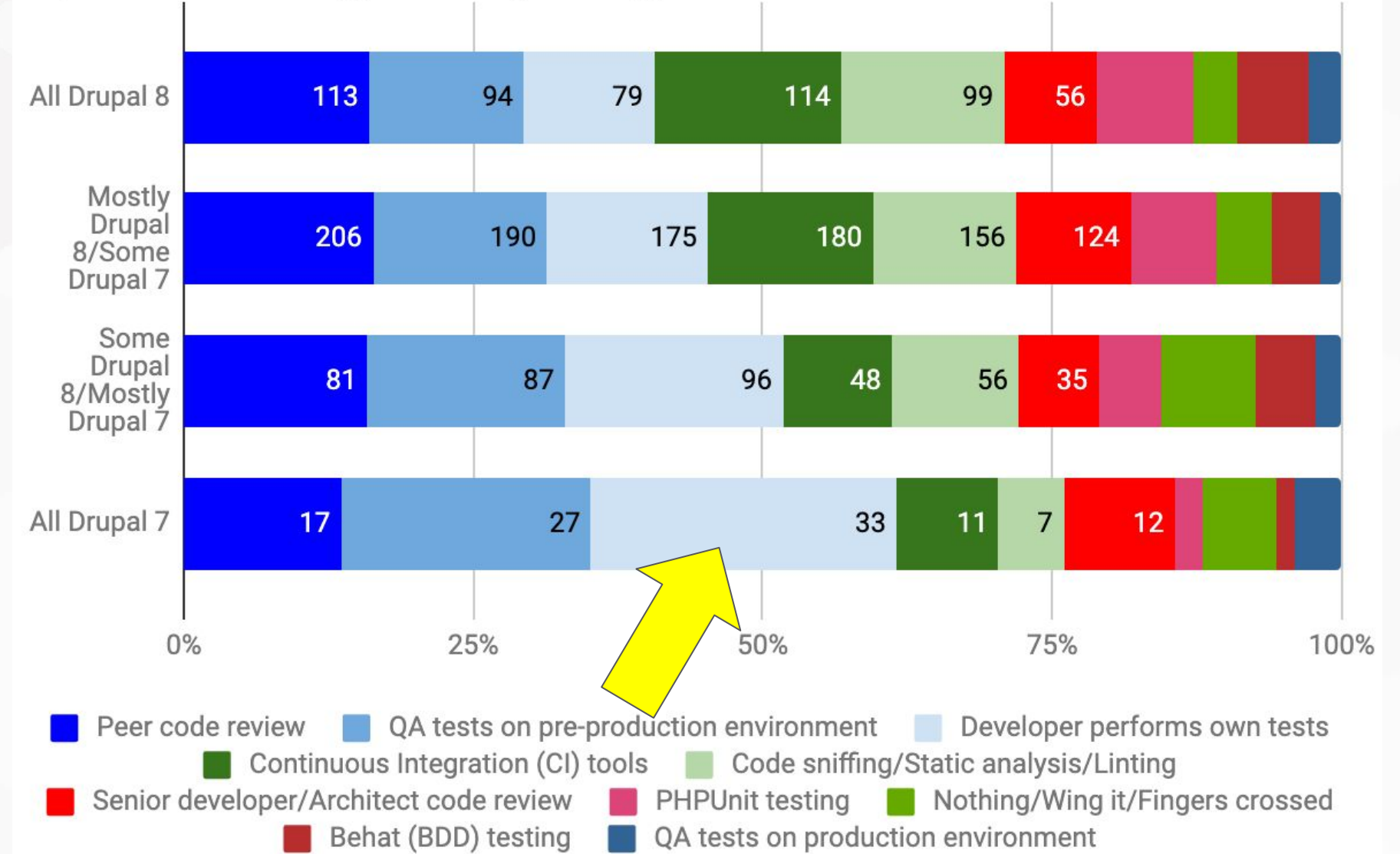

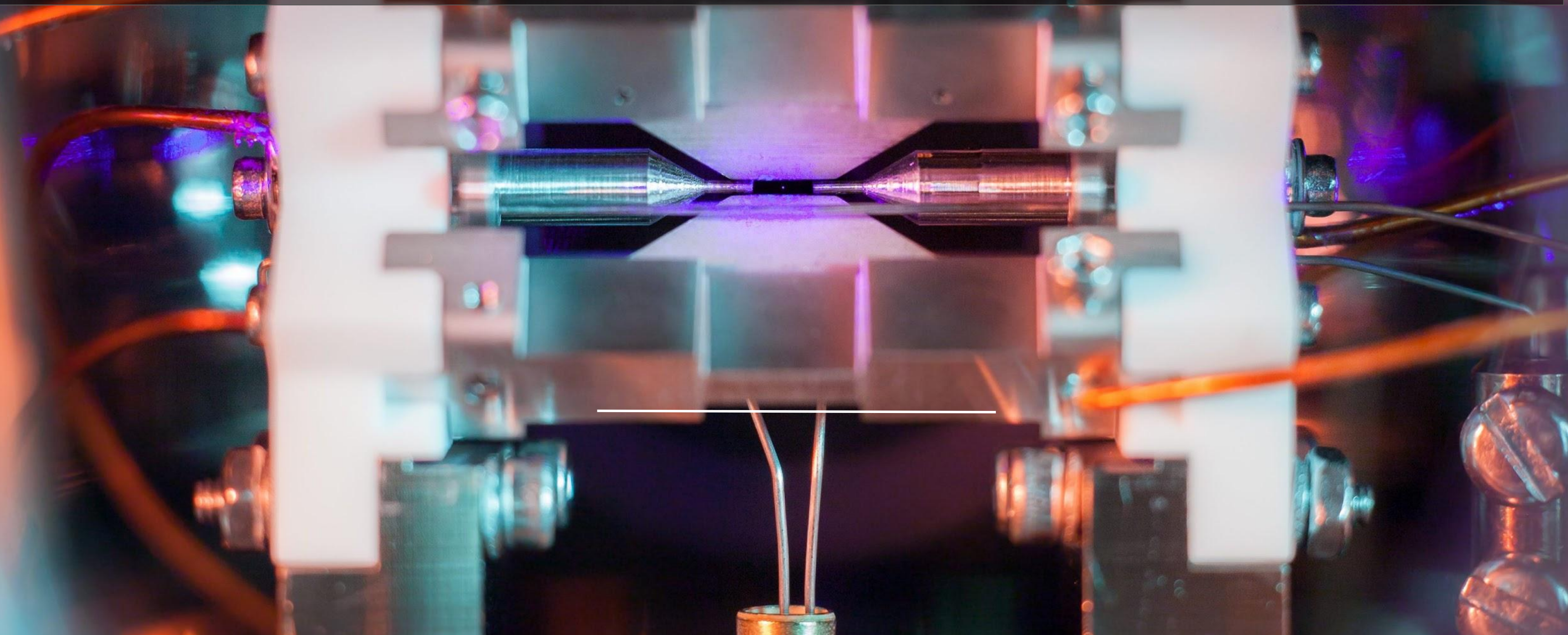
QA Methodology vs Drupal Team Size



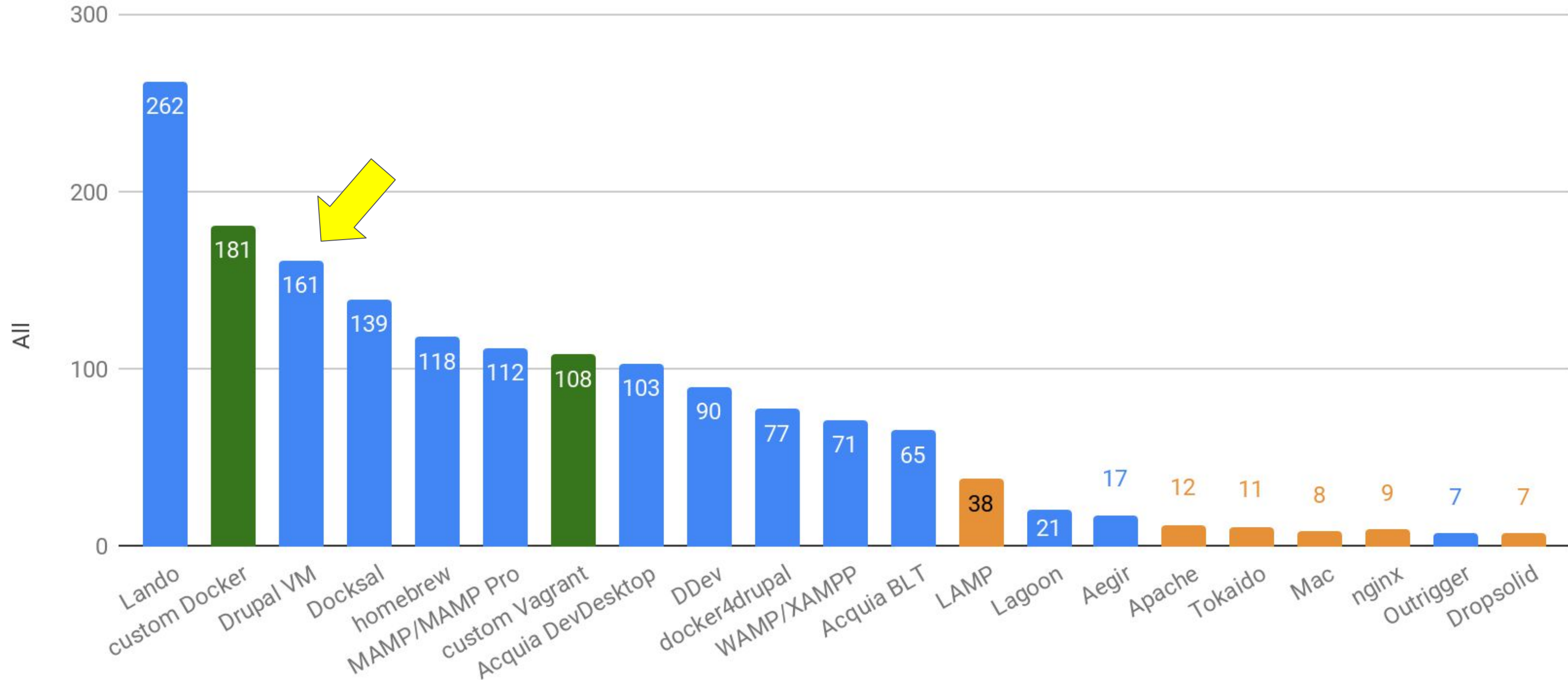
QA Methodology vs Project Type

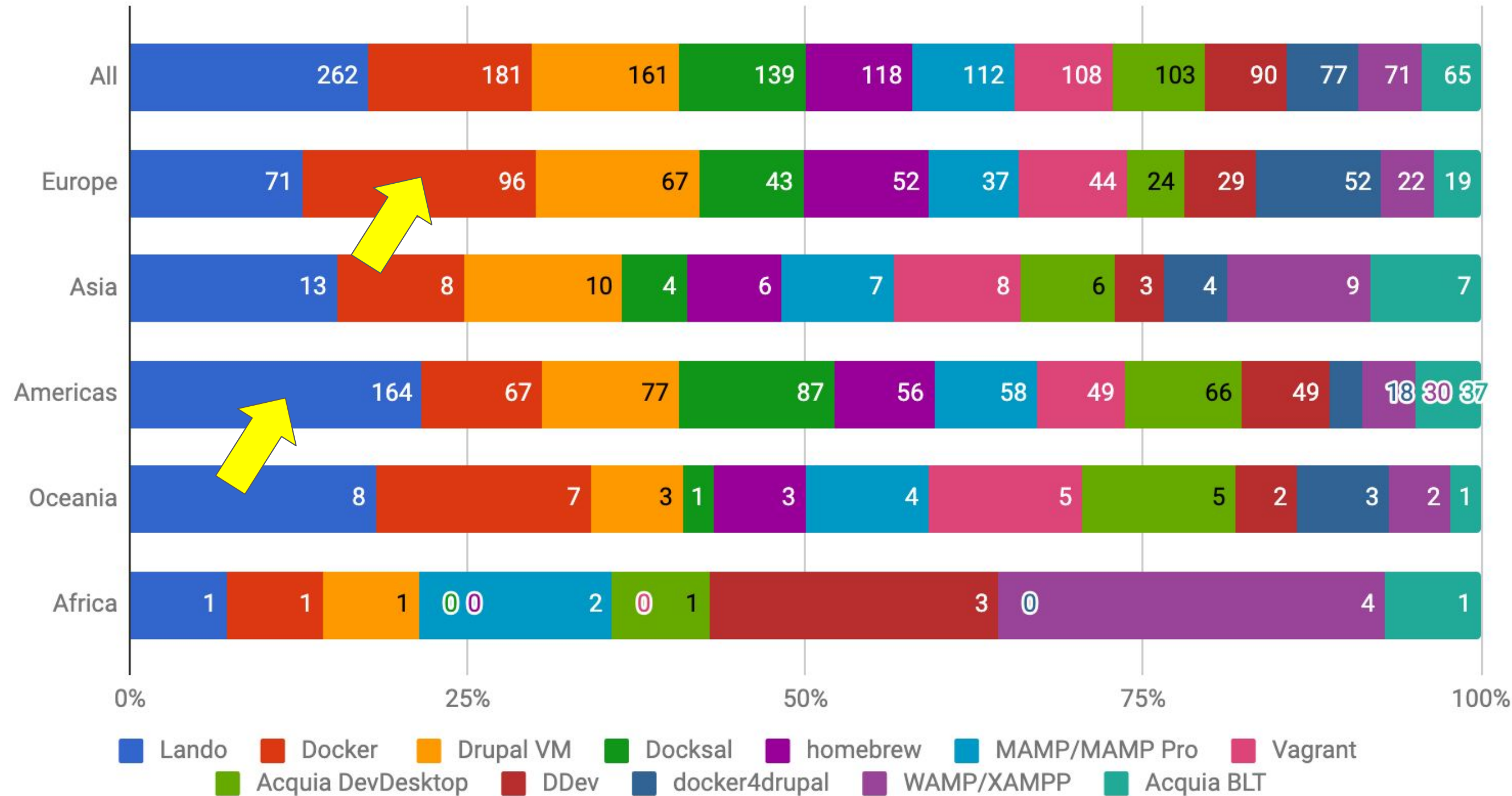

Lando (#3 in 2018) top overall, overtakes Drupal VM (1), custom Docker (2)

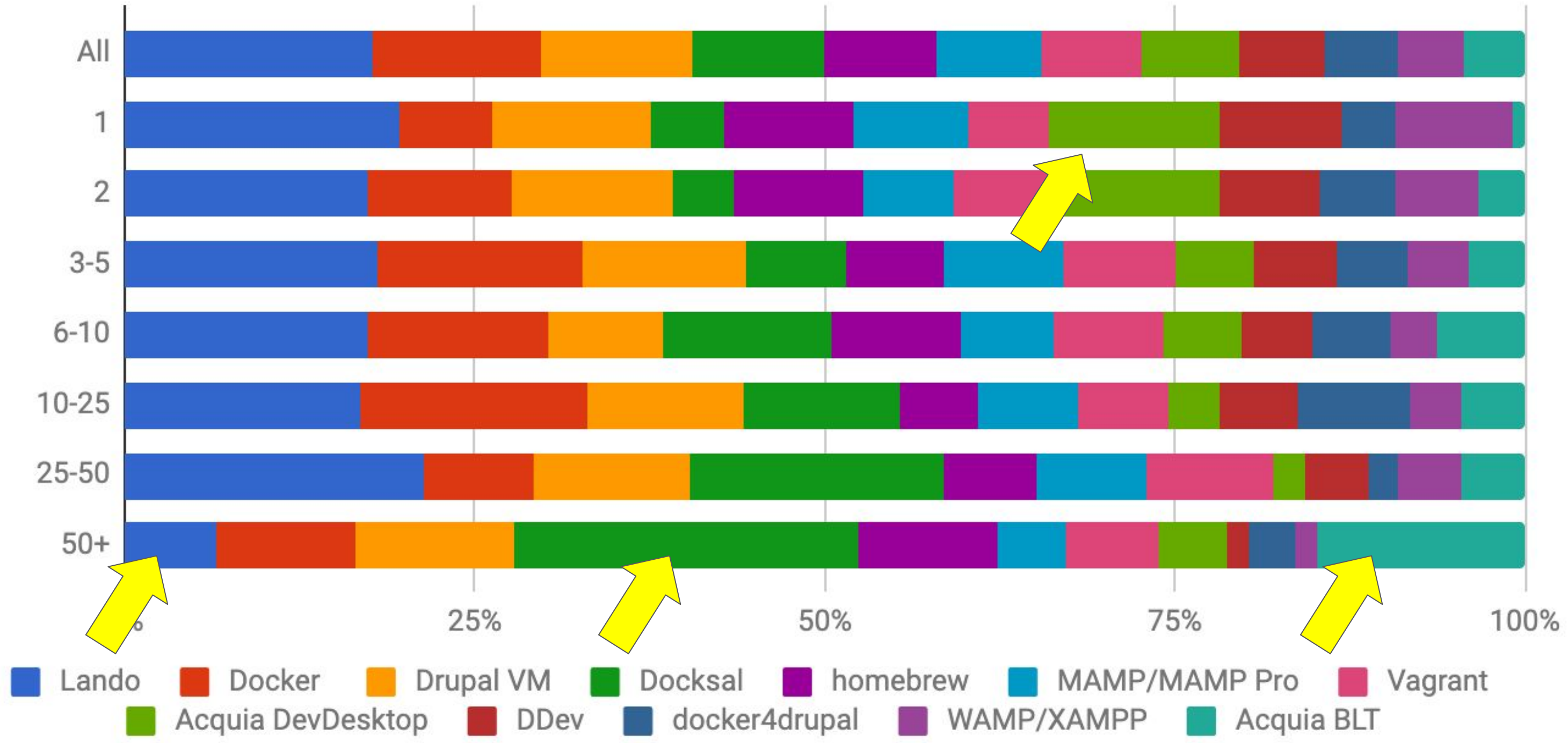
Custom Docker top favorite in Europe

Lando, Docksal popular in Americas

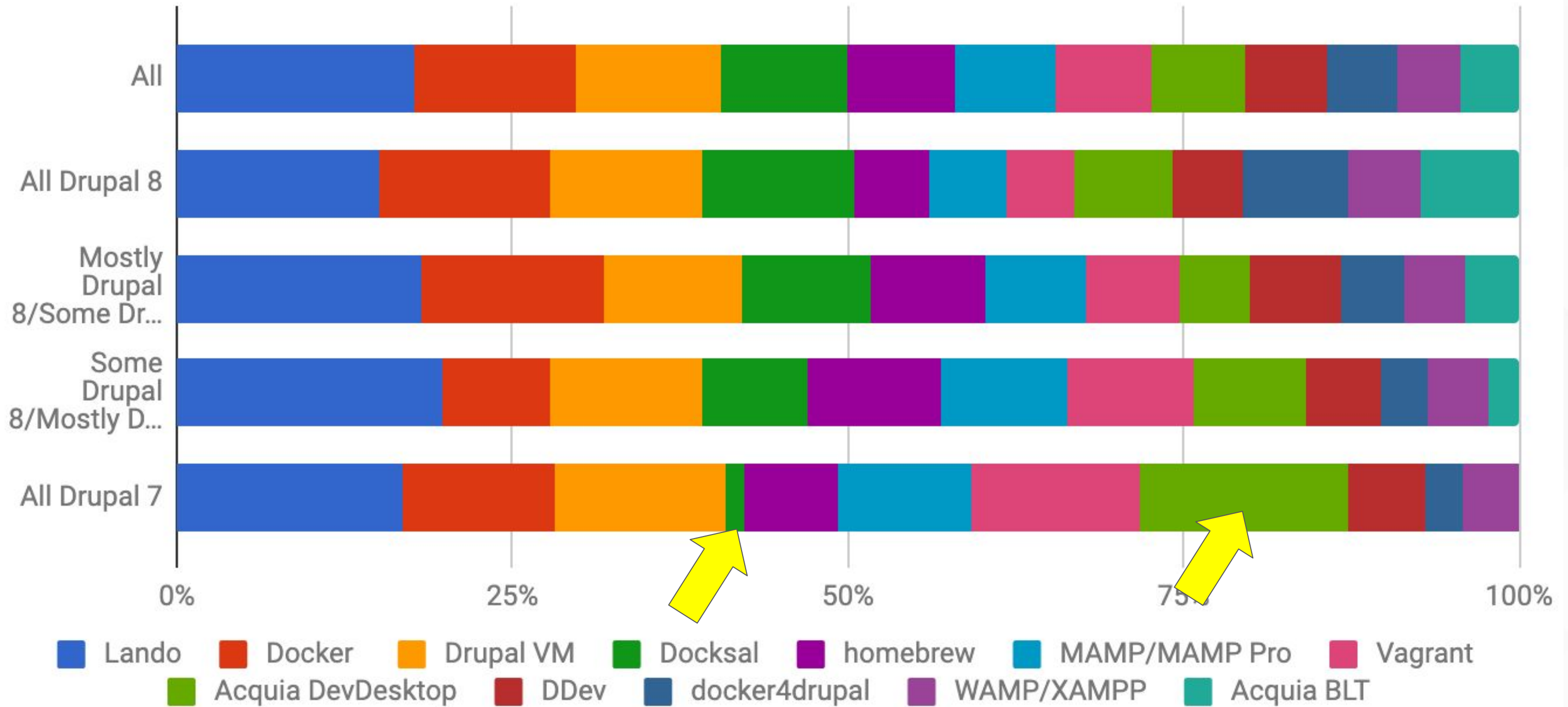
DDev, WAMP top in Africa

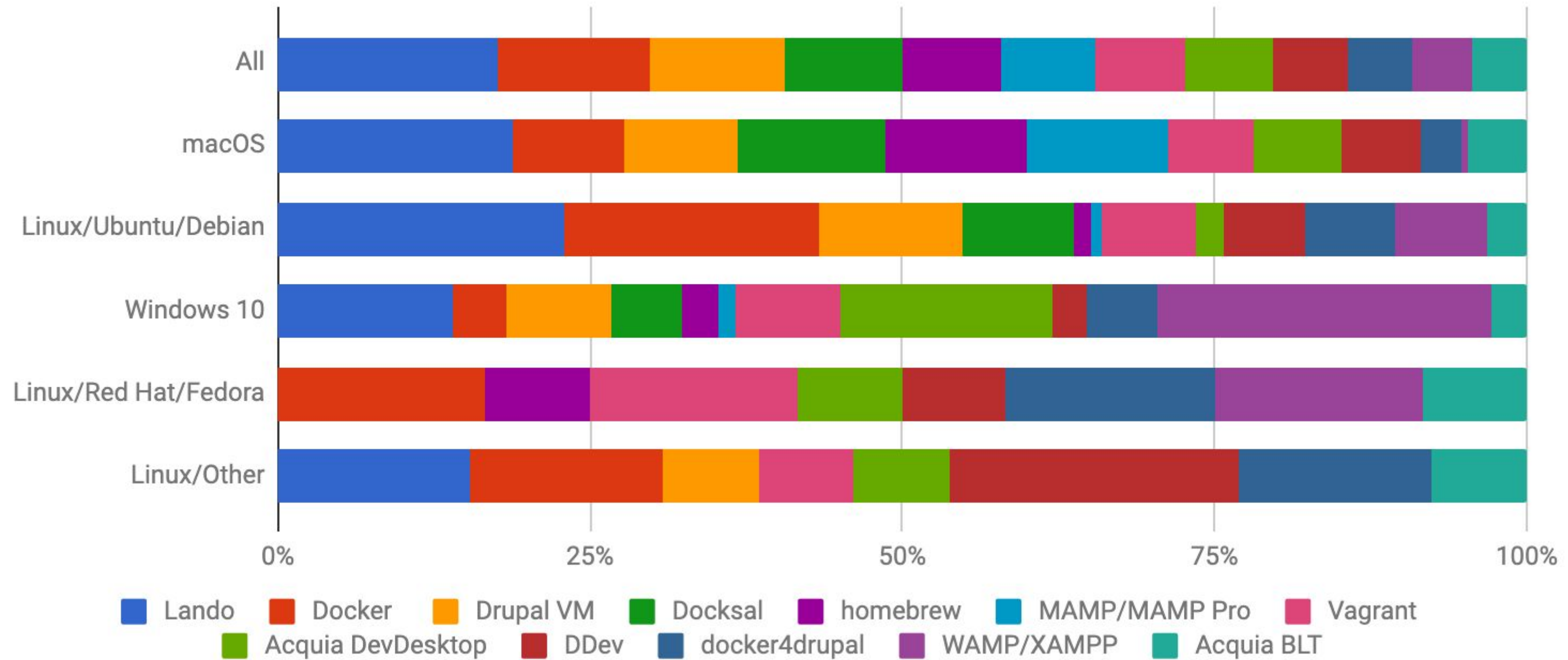




Local Development Tools by Project Type
