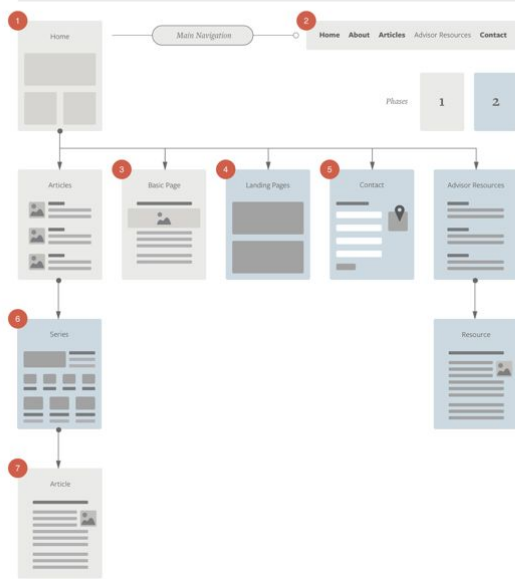

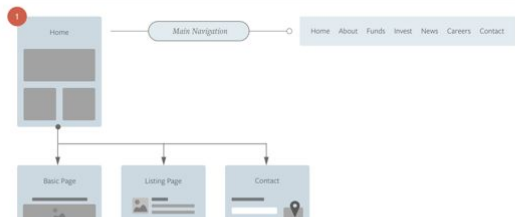

LONGBOARD: CONTENT MARKETING SITE



- 1 Version 1 of the homepage will aim for simplicity while achieving the goals, which include introducing the value proposition, introducing some of the valuable advisor resources (e.g. articles initially) and answering key questions advisors have.
- 2 Items in bold represent links that will be present at launch of phase 1.
- 3 Version 1 will allow for basic pages that contain text content with images. In phase 2 we will add more rich media and component insert options.
- 4 Rearrangible components within custom landing pages (e.g. for campaigns, SEO, etc.) will be tackled in phase 2.
- 5 In phase 1 we will use links to Markets pages for contact forms and the like. In phase 2 we will work to integrate forms more seamlessly into the site.
- 6 We will work to add series or "collections" in phase 2, allowing articles and resources to be grouped into special collections (e.g. for advisor resources).
- 7 Version 1 of articles will allow for basic long form text content with images. Things like insertion of other rich media, custom components and calls to action will be addressed in phase 2.

LONGBOARD: CORPORATE/FUNDS SITE (Phase 2)



- 1 The Corporate/Funds site will build on the same CMS platform and borrow from the basic layouts and patterns established in the Content Marketing Site. However we will design a custom "theme" for this site to differentiate it visually from the Content Marketing Site.

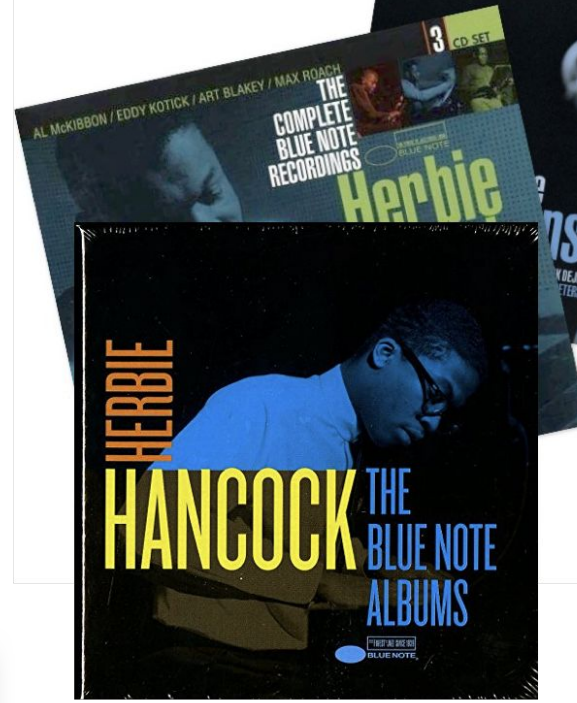

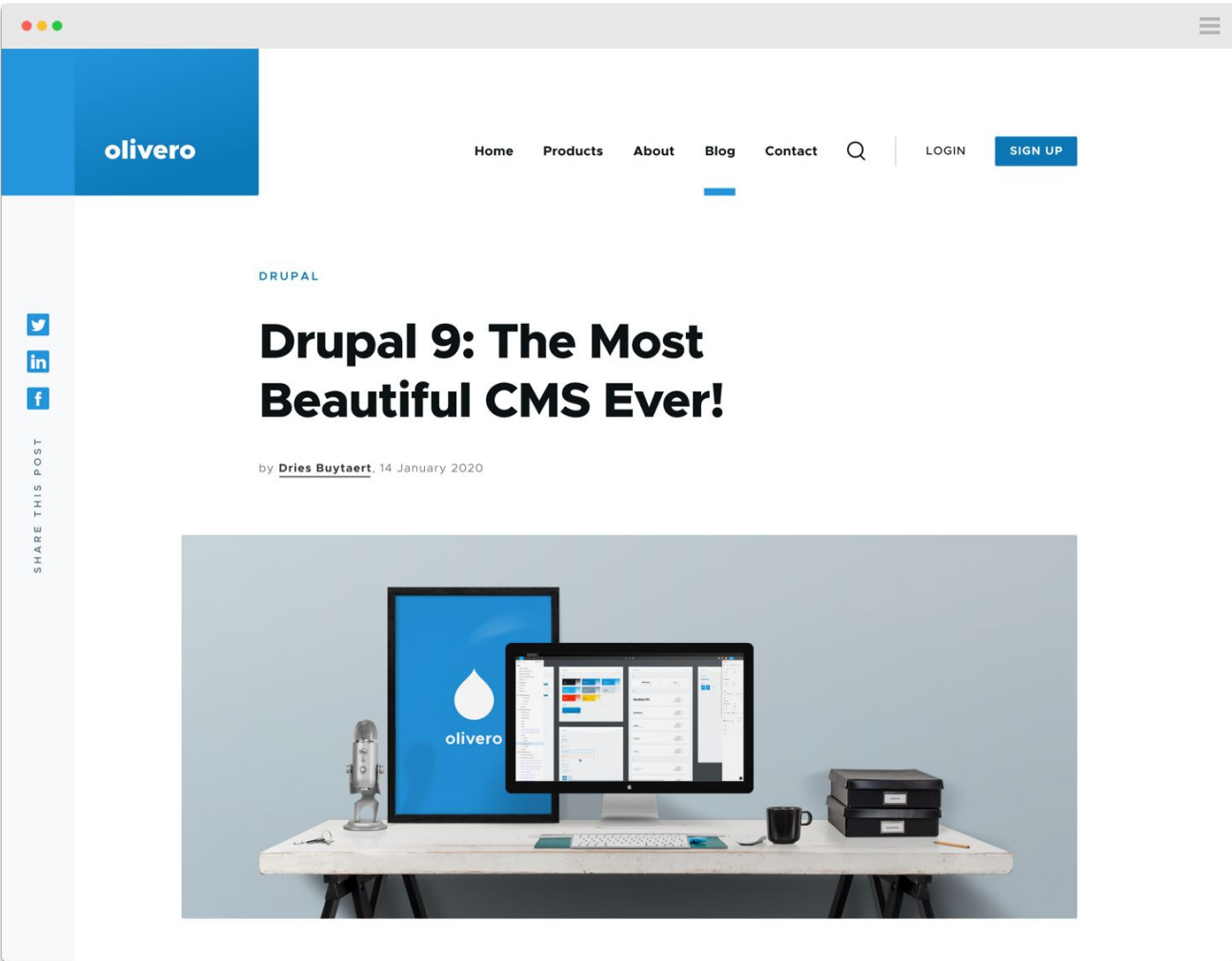



- Aim to conform with WCAG 2.1 Level AA success criteria. Note: not all criteria are the responsibility of a CMS theme.
- Support for the front page, node page, user page, contact form, and taxonomy pages.

Limitations

- Webfonts must meet Drupal.org distribution packaging requirements (<https://www.drupal.org/node/1475972>)
- No images for the hero/lead-space, except for a swappable Drupal logo, and an option for SVG pattern image that can add to the design.
- This theme will not have any support for the Color module
 - PostCSS can be used, but no CSS preprocessors
 - Vanilla JavaScript only

Timeline

While it would be amazing to get this new theme into Drupal 9.0, the timeline is fairly unrealistic. A more realistic timeline would be for the theme to be added in a Drupal 9 minor release (9.1 or 9.2).

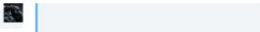

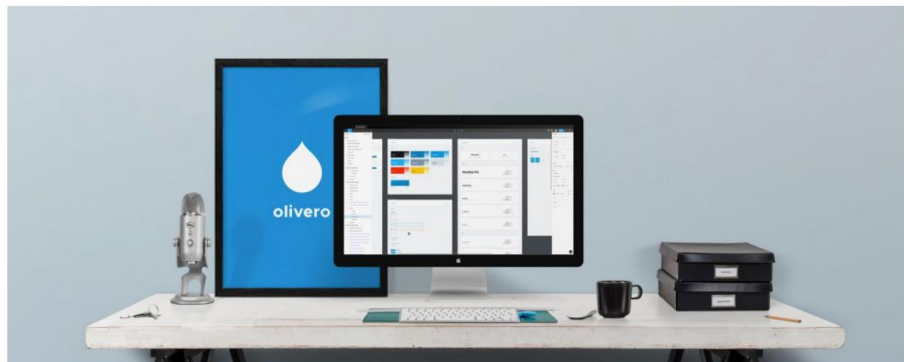

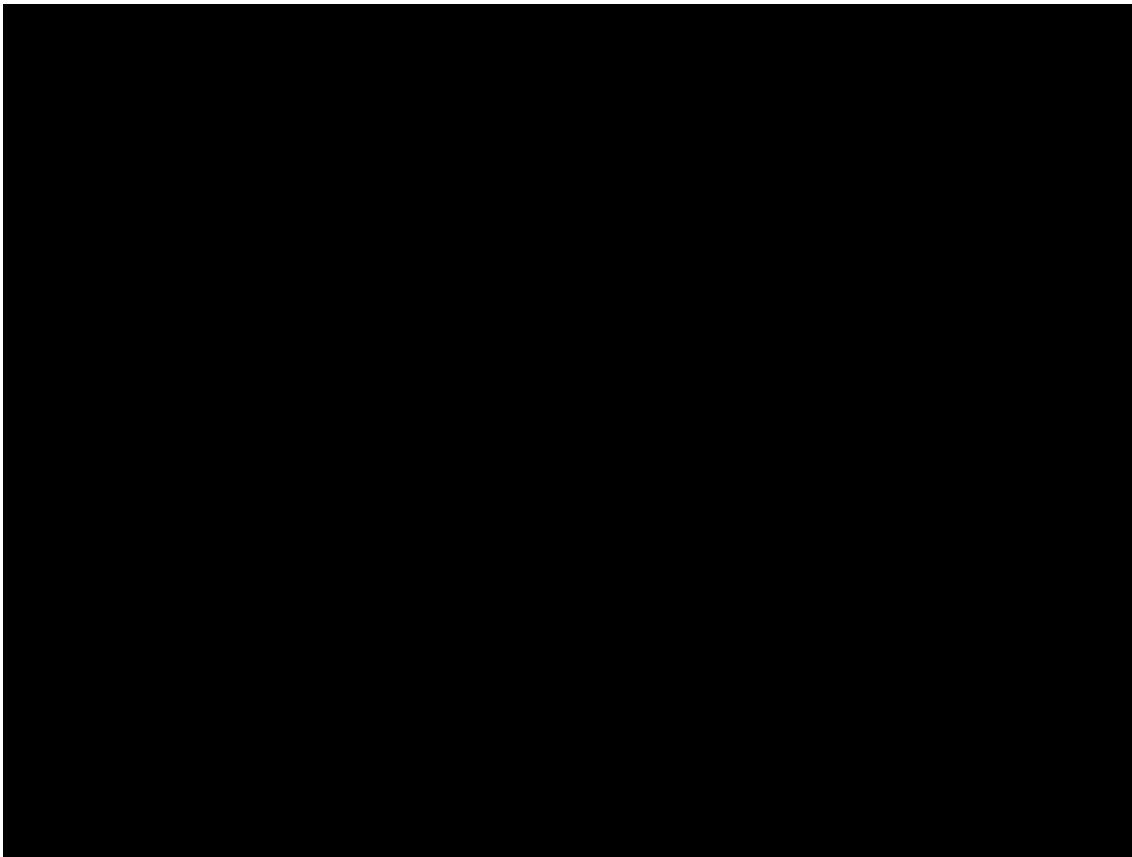

Summary

This issue is proposing a new design for the default frontend theme for Drupal 9 (targeted for inclusion in Drupal 9.1). Note this is separate from the [new administration theme, Claro](#), which was just committed to core several days ago.

This new frontend theme will have a modern look and feel based on adjectives and principles that were identified during the design process (more on this below). It will be [WCAG AA conformant](#), support updated functionality in Drupal, and is intended to feel modern going into the future. The theme is named "Olivero" after [Rachel Olivero](#), who was an advocate for accessibility and a Drupal community member (more on that below).

Need

The design of the current default theme ([Bartik](#)) has not changed since the release of Drupal 7 in January of 2011. While Bartik has proved itself to be versatile over the years, its design has aged with the years and fails to showcase Drupal's state-of-the-art power and functionality.

Goals

- **Updated modern design:** Our intention is to design a theme that feels modern and ages well. Design elements such as drop shadows, and gradients are used sparingly while typography, animation and color palettes have been thought out.
- **Functionality that supports new features:** We want the theme to include support for recent commonly used Drupal functionality such as second-level navigation, embedded media, layout builder, and more.
- **WCAG AA Conformance:** The theme will be WCAG AA conformant. We will be working closely with accessibility experts and the Drupal Accessibility team to ensure that the theme passes [Drupal's stringent accessibility standards](#) with flying colors.

We will work with the community to help ensure that the new theme is aligned with the above goals in order to create a successful theme.

Design Process

The first step was to solicit community feedback within the Drupal Core ideas queue: [#3064880: Create new default front-end theme](#). This issue confirmed that the idea to add a new theme is sought after by the community.

Once we knew our idea was valid and sought after by the community, we moved to identify the stakeholders for the design process that we deemed essential for the theme to be successful, and to help guide us throughout the process. The following community members were identified:

Pre-requisites

Before starting, ensure that you are using at least the latest [LTS release of Node.js](#), once Node.js has been installed, we recommend installing Yarn:

```
npm i -g yarn
```

For installation in Debian / Ubuntu and other systems, see [Yarn Installation](#).

Download the theme and enter the folder (from <https://www.drupal.org/project/olivero/git-instructions>):

```
git clone --branch 8.x-1.x-dev https://git.drupalcode.org/project/olivero.git
cd olivero
```

Install the required packages:

```
yarn install
```

Working on CSS

The project uses [PostCSS](#) for compiling CSS for better browser support. CSS source files are located in the `css/src` folder. The compiled CSS files can be found in `css/dist`. When making changes, the patch should include both `/css/src` and `/css/dist` files. (where `src` is where changes were made, and `dist` is the compiled result from yarn).

CSS scaffolding tasks are following the logic of the JavaScript tasks.

Process sources without writing source maps:

```
yarn run build:css
```

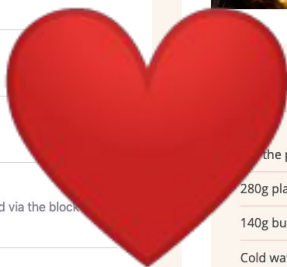
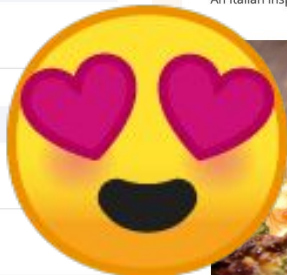

Recipe instruction
