## What is Composer?

Composer is an application-level package manager for the PHP programming language that provides a standard format for managing dependencies of PHP software and required libraries. It was developed by Nils Adermann and Jordi Boggiano, who continue to manage the project. Wikipedia

- Composer.lock
- vendor folder
- autoload.php
