


Abandoned projects

- Take over unmainted projects instead of publishing a fork
- Avoids duplication
- Your code gets to a well known place already
- Existing users benefit of your new developments
- If the maintainer does not respond you can get access in 2-3 weeks

- Required to push your code to drupal.org
- Version control tab on every project
- **❖** Branch name: 8.x-1.x
- ❖ Tag name: 8.x-1.0-beta1
- **❖ Docs:** https://www.drupal.org/documentation/git



Coding Standards

- **❖** Important for readable & understandable code
- Whitespace and indentation
- Naming conventions
- Inline documentation of classes and functions

Coder + PHPCS

```
$ phpcs --standard=Drupal example.module
FILE: /home/klausi/workspace/coder/example.module
FOUND 3 ERRORS AFFECTING 3 LINES
3 | ERROR | [ ] Missing function doc comment
4 | ERROR | [ ] Opening brace should be on the same line as the declaration

- Detects coding standard problems
- Can fix coding standard problems automatically

example.js: line 8, col 1, Error - Use the function form of 'use strict'. (strict)

- Checks coding standards in JavaScript files
- Drupal 8 ships with a .eslintrc config file

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Automated project review

Project application checklist

About

This service performs automated reviews of drupal.org projects using klausi's PAReview.sh script. It is intended to ease the review of project applications but can be used to check any other project as well. This online service provides the recent pareview script without installing a local testing environment.

Used PHP CodeSniffer standards:

Review a drupal.org project online



Licensing: GPLv2+

- All code on drupal.org is automatically GPLv2+
- No third party code allowed in git
- Libraries API to include third party code








Security Review

- Most important: your code should not be a threat
- How could an attacker abuse your module?
- What weaknesses does your code contain?
- ❖ Is your code ready for a production web site?
- **❖** Are you familiar with security concepts in Drupal?

Cross Site Scripting (XSS)

Reflected XSS example:

```
<?php
print 'You are on page number ' . $_GET['number'];
?>
```

↔ HTML:

You are on page number <script>alert("XSS");</script>

- Always sanitize user provided text (Drupal 7)
- Drupal 8: Twig auto escaping helps a lot



Cross site Request Forgery (CSRF)

Changing data without verifying intent

```
<img src="http://example.com/node/1/quickdelete" >
```

- trick admins into executing actions by just following a link
- Fix: use confirmation forms or
- use per user tokens in the path with drupal_get_token() and drupal_validate_token()

/node/1/quickdelete?token=tieya9bahhaeKeen60ow



Do you see the pattern?

- Don't trust any user provided data in the URL, the request, or content in the database.
- Attackers exploit missing/weak access control (permission setup)
- Attackers use browser features to perform actions behind the user's back (XSS, CSRF, open redirects).

Project application queue

- Applying for permissions to create full projects
- A usual issue queue
- Other people review your code

Application workflow

- **You open the application "needs review"**
- **❖** Reviewer finds major problem: "needs work"
- **❖** You fix the problem: "needs review"
- ❖ Reviewer OK: "reviewed & tested by the community
- **❖** Git admin approves: "fixed"
- ❖ You get the "git vetted user role" and can promote your project(s)





Problems

- Very long wait times for applicants (months)
- Too few regular reviewers and git admins
- Only projects of new contributors need to get reviewed (unfair?)
- Superficial feedback





Considerations

Why can't just everyone publish projects?

- Prevent name space squatting by random users
- Security team wants to support all of contrib
- Drupal's reputation about contributed modules
- Encourage collaboration over competition




Review Bonus

- 3 reviews of other projects
- issue tag "PAReview: review bonus"
- high priority list




Community networking

- Use and make connections with Druplistas
- Ask colleagues/friends to review your code
- Local meetups & user groups
- ***IRC**
- Drupal Answers
- Blog about your project
- Help and contribute to make yourself known



Benefits of reviewing


- Learn Drupal by reviewing code
- Learn about alternative ways
- Learn how to analyze foreign code
- Learn how to write secure code
- Learn about best and worst practices
- Stay on top of what is new and hot
- Build your Drupal career by helping and mentoring





Plans

- Automated reviews integrated into drupal.org
- **Every non-vetted user can promote 1 sandbox**
- ❖ No stable releases (only alphas, betas, RCs)
- **❖** No security team support for unstable releases
- Same approval process after that
