# Where we've been

---

# DrupalCon New Orleans

## (May 2016, Drupal 8.1)

- First discussion of a new Layout Initiative
- Put "Layout Plugin" in core
  - ❖ Became the Layout API in Drupal 8.3
- Put "Panelizer lite" in core
  - ❖ Would eventually become Layout Builder

# DrupalCon Baltimore

## (April 2017, Drupal 8.3)

- Attempted iterative approach via Field Layout
  - ❖ Allowed a single layout within Field UI, similar to Display Suite
- Began planning and design for new core module: "Layout Builder"
  - ❖ All credit due to Emilie Nouveau!
- First proof-of-concept written one month later at Acquia hackathon

# DrupalCon Nashville

## (April 2018, Drupal 8.5)

- Layout Builder added to core as an experimental module!
  - ❖ Missing support for revisions, Content Moderation, Quick Edit
  - ❖ Many known usability and accessibility issues
  - ❖ No flexibility to opt-in or opt-out of Layout Builder

# DrupalCon Seattle

## (April 2019, Drupal 8.7)

- Layout Builder is stable!
  - ❖ Translation integration still in development
  - ❖ Multiple opportunities to increase intuitiveness for all users
- Revisiting the migration path from Panelizer to Layout Builder

# Issue stats!

- 164 issues closed
  - ❖ 80 bugs
  - ❖ 70 tasks
  - ❖ 14 feature requests
- 123 total contributors
  - ❖ 60 repeat contributors (49%)
  - ❖ 19 contributors with 10+ credits
  - ❖ 40% of issues had at least one **volunteer** contributor

# Where we go next



## Translation Support

- Two separate approaches
  - ❖ "Synchronized Layout" translations
  - ❖ "Independent Layout" translations
- Needed on two levels
  - ❖ Per-bundle defaults (configuration)
  - ❖ Per-entity overrides (content)

# Roadmap

## Usability improvements

- Several tweaks to the "choose block" listing
- Re-evaluating usage of Contextual Links
- Real-time updates based on changes made in sidebar?

## Roadmap

# Accessibility improvements

- Add/improve usage of `Drupal.announce()` and ARIA attributes
- Allow easier keyboard access to actions (save, discard, revert) from anywhere on the page
- Create a tabledrag-based UI to make all changes at once

# Ecosystem modules

- Layout Builder Library
  - ❖ Replacement for Panelizer's "multiple defaults"
- Layout Builder Restrictions
  - ❖ Allows UI configuration of which blocks and layouts can be used
- Layout Builder Modal
  - ❖ Uses modals instead of the off-canvas dialog (sidebar)

# Documentation

- Full handbook outline in place
  - ❖ Many pages need filling in
  - ❖ New screenshots may be needed
- In-code documentation can always be improved!
